The school proposes 2 options for payment:

- in 1 installment with 500 euros off of the tuition fees
- in 2 installments without additional service charges.

The first installment due before the 21st of August.

If visas are pending or the student has been awarded a late acceptance, the first or total tuition payment is due no later than 10 business days after the student's receipt of visa or notification of late acceptance.

The above includes:

- Tuition fees
- Administration fees
- Access to the school's equipment for projects as validated by the Faculty
- For BFA and MFA programs: a contribution towards the EABHES fees (European Accreditation Board of Higher Education Schools)

EICAR students qualify for Health Insurance provided by the French Social Security under their terms and conditions.

Payment terms are available on the registration form.

Note: Students borrowing shooting equipment will need to provide a guarantee covering any damage incurred.

The fees above-named are valid for the academic year 2019-2020. Thereafter they are subject to adjustments to cater for cost variations.
